


# Tile Series Button Smart Panel 2.1

**Instruction Manual**

### ♦ Overview

Tile Series 1/2/3/4/8-button smart panel 2.1, with mechanical buttons, supports a variety of button modes and button control types. It can achieve basic control functions such as switch, dimming, colour temperature, RGB control, curtain, scene, etc. It also has a built-in temperature sensor to detect the local temperature and upload it to the Buspro cable; each group of buttons can be customized with laser engraving and support the RGB indication function of the buttons. The colour and brightness of button indicators can be customized through HDL commissioning software. Tile Series panels 2.1 have plastic and metal versions. Their excellent performance and wide range of application scenarios make them an ideal choice for modern home intelligent design solutions.



#### Main functions:

- Lighting control: switch, dimming, colour temperature, RGB
- Curtain control: support curtain opening, closing, and stopping percentage control
- Scene control: support one-button scene control
- Built-in temperature sensor: support sending local temperature value to the bus for scene and automation control condition input.
- RGB LED indication function: support customizing the brightness and colour of the button indicator light.
- Button locking function: support panel button locking function to prevent outsiders from manually controlling the panel or children from accidentally touching it.
- Proximity sensing function: support automatically sleep of the button indicator, the human body approaches to wake up
  the indicator.
- Button text laser engraving customization: support custom button laser engraving, according to user needs for text size
  and content engraving, making it easy to identify the control target of the button

Tile series button panels 2.1 include: 1/2/3/4/8 button panels, the front view of the panel and the button serial numbers are as follows:








- Before performing any installation or disassembly procedures, any maintenance or cleaning procedures on the device, it
  is crucial to disconnect the device from all voltage sources. This step is necessary to ensure the safety of the technician
  and prevent any potential damage to the device.
- It is a MUST to install the device with wall box.
- To protect this device and loads, it is recommended that a 10A circuit breaker be connected to each circuit.
- Do not use corrosive liquid to wipe the device body, especially the interface, so to avoid damage to the device.
- Prior to performing maintenance or cleaning on the device, disconnect the device from all voltage sources, to avoid electric leakage and electric shock.

## ♦ Wiring

- The device can be used with Buspro power supply interface, 2CH relay power interface and 4CH relay power interface.
- When a relay power interface is used, the panel can control the switching status of each circuit of the connected wireless
  device. For example, if a light is connected, it can be turned on or off by controlling the panel.
- For Buspro connection, a hand-in-hand connection is recommended. Please wire according to HDL standards: D+, D-,
   GND and +24V.

Note: It is a must to use the 2CH relay power interface and the 4CH power interface with 86 wall box.

2. 2CH relay power interface and the 4CH relay power interface:



### ♦ Installation

• Warning: Before installation, please cut off the power supply, it is strictly prohibited to operate with electricity.

**Step 1**. Install the wall box (the depth of wall box should not be less than 45mm) on the wall and lead out Buspro cable . Connect the cables, and pay attention to safe and reliable wiring.



Step 2. Insert the power interface into the bracket.



Step 3. Use screws to fix the power interface in the wall box.



**Step 4.** Align the panel pins with the interface holes, press gently and install on the interface.

### Step 5. Install the frame.




## ♦ Disassembly

Warning: Before performing any disassembly procedures on the device, it is crucial to disconnect the device from all voltage sources. This step is necessary to ensure the safety of the technician and prevent any potential damage to the device.

Step 1. It is recommended to use a screwdriver to pry the panel open from the bottom.

Step 2. To remove the panel and power base, please refer to the section Installation and do it reversely.



### ♦ Operation

- **1. Programming mode**: Long press any button for 15 seconds, the backlight will turn blue and flash slowly, and the programming mode is on (in programming mode, the subnet ID and device ID can be modified in the commissioning software)
- 2. Panel lock/unlock (Tile Series 1 button smart panel 2.1 doesn't have this function):

Manual lock: short press A1 and the last button at the same time for 5 seconds, the indicator light flashes blue (power off and re-power on, the panel is still locked)

Auto-lock: users can configure the auto-lock function in the HDL Studio commissioning software, set the auto-lock time, and the panel will be locked automatically after a certain period of time.

Panel unlock: press A1 and the last button at the same time for 5 seconds, the panel will be unlocked.

Note: Unlocking must be done manually.

- **3. Customize the colour of the button indicator:** support colour customization through the commissioning software (please refer to the commissioning instructions for details).
- **4. Proximity sensor function setting:** support setting of sensing distance and time of the sensor waking up panel indicator through the commissioning software (please refer to the commissioning instructions for details).
